We have had another busy week of learning in Year 2 this week - the children have continued to impress us with their positivity and excellent attitudes to learning.

This week in English, the children have been inventing their own story based on 'My Friend the Weather Monster'. They have been given freedom with their writing as they create their own character, setting, problem and solution. Next week, we are beginning a new three-week unit where they will be writing non-chronological reports about countries. They will start by rewriting a report on Wales.

In Maths this week, the children have been learning about division using concrete resources and pictures. We have been impressed by the children's efforts and the resilience they've shown. Next week, we will be moving on from multiplication and division to work on statistics. The children will be working with tally charts and pictograms which use different scales (1, 2, 5 and 10).

Geography walk around Fairlands

As part of our topic on The UK, we are going to be introducing the children to simple maps and map symbols. We will be taking the children on a walk of Fairlands Estate to develop these skills in their local area.
