Dear Parents / Carers,

We have had a wonderful time in Year 3 this week - the children have continued to impress us with their positivity and excellent attitudes to learning.

In English, the children have changed the things that Leon sees/hears/smells in the Place Between. They have continued to use expanded noun phrases in their writing as well as learning about and including alliteration. Next week, we will be introducing the children to similes and encouraging the children to use them when they write about a new setting that a child visits.

In Maths, we continued to practise multiplying a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number and then moved onto dividing a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number. We have been using place value grids and dienes or counters to help us with our working out. Next week, we will continue with division, then we will then finish our unit on multiplication and division with some problem-solving activities.

For the next two weeks in Spelling we will be learning to add im- to root words beginning with m or p. Here are some examples: impatient, impolite, impossible, immortal, imperfect, immature
