Curriculum

As artists we have drawn outlines of fruit and used shading to colour. We have used coloured pencils to create light and dark tones.

As athletes we have continued to focus on the skills hit, run and catch. We used our hitting skills to self-feed the ball and hit the ball to aim at a target.
