What a great week we have had in Year 2 this week. We would like to start by saying how incredibly proud we are of how well the children behaved and represented the school on our walk of Fairlands on Wednesday afternoon. They were engaged with the task of creating a map of the local area using their own symbols and their behaviour was amazing. We also want to say a huge thank you to those parents who came along for the walk. We really appreciate you giving up your time so that the children could enjoy this experience.

This week in English, the children have been writing non-chronological reports about Wales. They have been focusing on grouping information into paragraphs and using subheadings to help the reader understand the text. Next week, we will be using the structure of the Welsh report to tweak and write our own reports about England.

In Maths this week, the children have been learning about division using concrete resources and pictures. We have been dividing by 2, 5 and 10. Next week, we will be moving on from multiplication and division to work on statistics. The children will be working with tally charts and pictograms which use different scales (1, 2, 5 and 10).

On Mondays and Fridays we have PE lessons. As a reminder please do not send the children into school in jewellery or earrings that they cannot take out themselves. Also please remember to send your child into school with a water bottle as keeping hydrated is important.
