

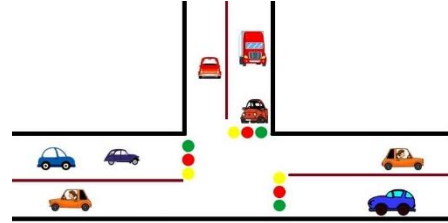

ROADWORKS
