Dear Parents / Carers,

The children all looked fantastic dressed as book day characters on Thursday! We have taken part in lots of activities during the week including a drama workshop based on Matilda, a visit from an author and writing character descriptions for our characters.

In English, the children have tweaked the text to write diary entries from the point of view of someone who visited the Iron Age. The children have written about the daily lives of people in this time, including facts about food, clothes and houses. Next week, we are continuing to write diary entries but are going to let the children's imaginations run wild as the children write about what life will be like in the future!

In Maths, the children have made great progress in being able to answer reasoning and problem-solving questions. We have not finished our unit on statistics so next week we will be moving onto measuring length using m, cm and mm. We will also be adding, subtracting and comparing lengths.

Next week, we are continuing to add the suffix -ly. Here are some examples: nicely, politely, finally, gently, horribly, simply, carefully, suddenly.
