In English this week, the children have enjoyed writing stories about Mr Grumpy. In Maths, the children have been learning to add and subtract lengths. We have recapped how to use column addition and subtraction as a method to help us solve calculations. Next week, we are going to be learning about perimeter.

Next week, in Spelling, we are continuing to learn about words ending in -ture. Here are some examples: mixture, adventure, future, picture, nature, creature, capture, furniture, temperature.
