In Maths, the children have been learning all about perimeter. We began by finding the perimeter of squares and rectangles then moved onto finding the perimeter of other 2D shapes, including rectilinear shapes. Next week, we are beginning our unit on fractions. We will be recapping halves, quarters, thirds and the difference between unit and non-unit fractions.
