

Long Term Plan Theme: Habitats and Homes

Curiosity (Engagement)

We will develop our curiosity through investigating habitats and why they are good for the animals that live there. We will show curiosity in learning about our world and the physical and human features in it.

Teamwork / Independence

We will continue to work with talk partners to share ideas. We will work together when taking turns and sharing resources and show increasing independence in using our writing skills across the curriculum.



Resilience

We will develop our resilience by approaching all learning tasks with our best effort. We will try to tackle new problems in maths and 'try, try, try again' if it doesn't work the first.

Empathy

We will build our skills in empathy by supporting our friends to become independent learners. We will help others when they are finding something difficult and show how we take care of our peers when they are upset.

As mathematicians	As mathematicians, we will be learning how to measure and compare length and height in cm. We will be learning to tell half past and o'clock times and start talking about quarter to and past. We will measure the volume of objects and explore the place value of numbers up to 100.
As readers and writers	As readers and writers, we will be looking at the story 'The Storm Whale' and use it to embed previous skills as well as extending our understanding of sentence starters. We will then be exploring the story 'Hector the Hermit Crab' and use this to learn more about conjunctions and how to use them to add more detail to our writing. In reading we will be recapping all of our year One phonics, including all the alternative sounds and spellings.
As scientists	As scientists, we will learn about habitats. We will explore where different animals live and why.
As geographers	As geographers, we will be learning about physical and human features in the world around us.
As computing experts	As computing experts, we will be developing our understanding of spreadsheets using Purple Mash. We will continue to learn about safety and how to keep ourselves safe online.
As artists	As artists, we will be exploring how to use watercolours to paint backgrounds and using this to create habitat pictures. We will look at the work of Andy Goldsworthy and make our own art from natural materials.
As musicians	As musicians we will explore pitch and understand the relationship between pulse and rhythm.
As athletes	As PE experts, we will be developing our skills in running, throwing and jumping. We will also be developing our gymnastic skills.
As religious experts	As religious experts, we will learn about why Jesus told parables and some of the parables he told.
