Curriculum

As writers we have been using a text map to retell the story of 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar.' Our learning focus has been to use both familiar and new punctuation correctly including commas in a list.

As mathematicians we have been solving one step problems involving multiplication. We have used picture representations and numicon to help us with this. We have written repeated addition number sentences to match picture representations too!

As artists we have been learning about the artist Matisse. We have used his work as inspiration to create our own pieces.

In LfL we have learnt about the importance of not keeping secrets that make us feel uncomfortable, anxious or afraid.

As religious experts we have looked at the symbols of Easter and thought about why they are important and what they signify.

As Athletes we have developed the skill of stopping and starting at speed. We used quick feet to collect and place bean bags and worked hard to beat our own scores.
