### **Parent Helpers**

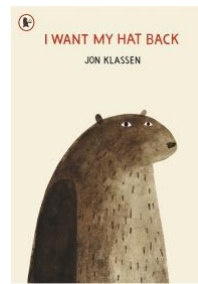
