It has been lovely to see all of the children back at school this week! This half term, we are continuing with our topic on the Stone, Bronze and Iron Ages – today we went to the field and imagined what it was like to be a hunter gatherer.

In English, we have written part of the story of The Tear Thief. This story has so much wonderful description so we have been working on including this in our writing (fronted adverbials, similes, alliteration, adverbs, exciting verbs, expanded noun phrases and prepositional phrases). Next week, we will continue to use description as we change the time of day that the Tear Thief visits and therefore the reasons that children are crying.

In Maths, we have begun a unit of work on fractions. We have been recapping learning on halves, quarters and thirds. After the holidays, we will continue to learn about fractions, including learning to count in fractions and exploring tenths.
