Dear Parents / Carers,

We have had another great week in Year 3! The children have been spending time in assemblies talking about our value of the month: Courage. It has been lovely to see the children trying to be courageous and try new things during the school day. May's value of the month is Tolerance.

In English, we have changed the time of day that the Tear Thief visits and therefore the reasons that children are crying. Some ideas include the Tear Thief visiting in the morning where a child is crying because they don't like breakfast, the Tear Thief visiting at lunchtime where a child has fallen over and the Tear Thief visiting in the middle of the night where a child has woken up from a nightmare. In Maths, we have been learning about tenths and then finding unit and non-unit fractions of amounts. Next week, we are moving on to learning about equivalent fractions, beginning with making fraction walls.
