What another great half term in Year 3! We are so proud of all of the children's hard work this term. We would like to wish you all a happy and restful half term and we look forward to welcoming the children back on Monday 6th June for their last half term in Year 3.

In English, the children have enjoyed writing letters to someone of their choice. Some children chose a family member or a friend while others chose a teacher or a celebrity. In Maths, the children have continued to practise telling the time to one-minute intervals as well as understanding am and pm. After half term, we will continue learning about time for one more week where we will be finding and comparing durations. Please continue to reinforce this learning at home by encouraging the children to use analogue and digital clocks to tell the time.
