We hope you all had a fantastic half term. The children have settled back into school and learning really well. Magpies are very excited to welcome their parents into school next week on Friday 17th June for their class assembly.

Our Learning

In English, the children have begun writing biographies of Queen Elizabeth II. The children have really enjoyed writing these on paper to create a leaflet and will continue them in English next week, adding photos, fact boxes and a front cover. Towards the end of next week, the children will create a made-up person of their choice and begin to plan a biography about them.

In Maths, the children have been working on finding and comparing durations. We have been counting in 5-minute intervals on our clocks to help us find start and finish times. Next week, we move onto our unit on properties of shape. We will begin by learning about different types of angles (acute, obtuse and right angles) and lines (horizontal and vertical).

Recorder Assembly

Year 3 will be performing on the recorder to the rest of the school on Monday 11th July. Magpies will be performing Joe Joe, Starlings will perform Hot cross buns and Sparrows will perform Lucy Locket. They will also be playing Mamma Mia as a whole group piece.
