	Research a UK river and present your findings in any way you would like to!	
	Try a food you have never had before and review it. Describe the taste, colour, texture and smell. Can you rate it out of 5 stars?	
	Create a model of a UK coastline. Can you include some features we have learnt about? (cliff, cave, arch, stack, stump, dune, spit, bay, headland) Eg lego, magnetic tiles and play dough.	
	Go for a sensory walk. What can you hear, see, smell and feel?	
	Listen to a piece of classical music (Youtube). How does it make you feel? Draw a piece of art work to reflect this.	
	Cook something that involves melting a solid (eg chocolate) or demonstrate evaporation (eg cooking a sauce). Make sure you do this with an adult.	
	Design a new front cover for a book you have read.	
	Do something nice for someone else. How did it make them and you feel?	
	Write and perform a poem. It can be about anything!	
	Make up a game and teach it to someone else. Can you create a list of rules?	
	Create a piece of artwork to show a UK area/ landmark.	
	Research and create a fact file about something that interests you.	
	Make a song/ rhyme to help you remember a times table that you find tricky.	
	Try a new sport/ exercise that you haven't done before.	
	Create a dance routine to a song you like!	
	Create a map of your home, garden or a local area.	
	With support, learn how to sew a button onto some fabric! If you can already sew, use your skills to create something.	
	Visit London Museum and visit the The Secret Life of the Home Object Gallery—present your visit in an interesting way!	
	Visit Dapdune Wharf or part of the River Wey. Find where this is on a map. Take some photos of interesting features.
