# EVERY DAY COUNTS

With every day jam packed with fun and learning, Mrs O'Brien would like to take this opportunity to remind all parents that every day lost to education can have a serious impact on children's attainment and emotional well-being. Currently, she is increasingly worried about our whole school attendance

which is 95.2% against our target of 96.1%. It is clear from our weekly analysis that there are particular families who are not supporting our Attendance Policy, taking holidays in term time (from one year to the next) which leads to children missing learning time, missing social time with friends and brings significant pressure on teaching staff to find ways for children to catch up on missed lessons. There is a strong link between attendance and children's academic achievement. Please help us to deliver the best possible education for your children by ensuring that they have good attendance.

# FEEDBACK

As you know, we are always keen to hear your feedback (both what is going well and what needs to improve). Please can we ask you, respectfully, to use the correct channels when providing feedback i.e. via your child's class teacher, a senior leader or Mrs O'Brien. It has been brought to our attention that there have been occasions that parents are providing this feedback via social media including WhatsApp groups set up to provide valuable communication and reminders about school life, rather than directly to the school. # CLUB4

As part of its pandemic response, in 2021 the government expanded its Holiday Activity and Food (HAF) programme to cover the whole country. At the end of 2021, the government agreed a 3-year extension to the programme, funded

nationally by the Department of Education to directly help families and individuals who are the hardest hit. Known in Surrey as Club4, the scheme offers free holiday activity camps for children and young people from reception to year 11 (inclusive) who are in receipt of benefits-related Free School Meals (FSM). Club4 provides a wide variety of activity camps to ensure children have the chance to enjoy a wonderful range of enriching activities, physical activity, nutritional education and a meal each day, in over 140 locations across Surrey.

The Club4 holiday activity camps run during the main school holidays (Christmas, Easter and Summer). The programme is coordinated by Active Surrey on behalf of Surrey County Council. It is a separate offer to Surrey County Council's supermarket voucher. Families can use both schemes.
