One of our actions from the questionnaire was to audit the sugar content of the cereals that we serve at Early birds as some parents felt that the cereal options are unhealthy.

The cereals served contain the following sugar intake:

Shreddies	6%
Cheerios	6%
Rice Krispies	6%
Rice Krispie shapes	6%
Multigrain shapes	5%
Multigrain boulders	6%
Weetabix	2%
Cornflakes	3%



We will continue to monitor the sugar intakes in the cereals that we are providing. We serve the 'best of both' bread as we wasted lots of the wholemeal bread. We will trial again after Christmas.
