What a wonderful week it has been! The children have wrapped up warm and been outside exploring the wonderful weather.

<u>This week</u>

In Literacy, we tweaked 'The Snail and the Whale' by adding a different sea creature who went on an adventure with the snail. We created our own zig-zag book on the story focusing on what happens at the beginning, middle and end of the story.

In Maths, we have revisited looking at composition of numbers to 5, digging deeper by children working out different ways to make numbers e.g. 3 + 2, 1 + 4, 0+5.

In PSED, we have explored how we can use kind words to encourage others. We will link our learning to our 'learning powers' and how by being a teamwork Bee that we can help others both through our words and actions.

Phonics

This week the children have learnt; **ure, er, OW (go slow** in the snow). We have revised the following harder to read and spell words; **ball, tall.**

Please continue to hear your child read and encourage them to spot taught sounds and blend to read words. Regular practice of recognising harder to read and spell words will also be a great support. We really appreciate your partnership in helping your child to read.
