Dear Parents / Carers,

We would like to take this opportunity to thank you all for your ongoing support. We can't believe we are already half way through the year. We are so proud of everything the children have achieved so far!

<u>This week</u>

In Literacy, we have learnt all about animals in their natural environments. We have discussed how it is helpful for us all to look after the environment. We have linked our learning back to the story 'Dear Greenpeace' and written letters about ways we can help look after the environment e.g. putting litter in the bin.

In Maths, the children have really enjoyed using balance scales to learn about mass / weight. They have explored what happens to the balance when objects are placed in the pans. We have used the words heavy / light / heavier / lighter to compare different objects.

In UW (understanding the world) we read the story 'Somebody swallowed Stanley' written by Sarah Roberts. We have explored how important it is to put litter in the bin and used the story to promote discussions about how we all play a part in looking after our world.

Phonics

This week has been review week in Phonics and we have revised all previously taught sounds. Please see all the sounds taught so far this term. Please continue to practice these at home with your child.
