Curriculum

As writers we have been writing our retelling of How to Catch a Dragon. Our focus is finding the verb in each sentence. Here is a video of the story : <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=QHDeEJ-9utI>

As mathematicians we have been subtracting using concrete objects, pictorial representations, and mentally, including one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20, including zero. We have counted back on a number line and found the difference between two numbers.

As designers we have designed and made products with a winding mechanism.

As athletes we are continuing a second unit called Hit, Run, Catch. This week we have run between bases to score points as part of a game and used over arm and under arm throwing techniques.

As computing experts we have used 2Create a Story on PurpleMash. We have selected a background and drawn a character for our story.

As historians we have placed events and artefacts on a timeline and talked about the past, present and future in our lives.

In Learning for Life we have thought about how to make healthy lifestyle choices.

Phonics



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In phonics we have are reviewing the alternatives we learnt before half term.

It is really helpful if the children can use the sheet that we sent home to practise the graphemes learnt. The word mats that also came home are words that children need to read and spell by the end of Year 1 so any work on these is also helpful.

The banded books that have been sent home match your child's phonic knowledge so please hear them read at least **3 times a week and record it in their reading diary.**

Numbots

NumBots is an online game and playing little and often will significantly improve your child's recall and understanding of number bonds and addition and subtraction facts. These are critical foundations in maths so we are excited by the impact NumBots will have. It would be helpful if your child could spend some time at home playing on NumBots.
