Friday 3rd March

We have had another exciting week in Year 3. We started the week with our first swimming lesson. The children thoroughly enjoyed them and they displayed our school values at all times by being respectful, patient and courageous. We are very proud of them! Just a reminder, that swimming lessons will be happening every Monday until May half term.

In English, we have begun a new writing unit based on the book 'The Stone Age'. The children eagerly used the knowledge they gained during last week's trip to write the story about a boy who time-travels to the Stone Age. We are focussing on using different sentence types in our writing and will be developing this further during the next two weeks.

In maths, we started a new unit about measurement. The children spent this week learning about units of length – mm, cm and m. They showed great curiosity and resilience when converting between the units so that they could compare and order measurements.

In Science, we are learning about nutrition and spent time thinking about healthy and unhealthy food types. In History, we watched a 3D tour of a real-life 5000-year-old Neolithic village called Skara Brae and learned about what life would have been like living there during the Stone Age.

Starlings class finished the week with their class assembly all about the Stone Age. We are very proud of their achievement and teamwork.
