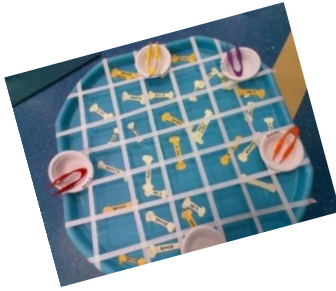
CAKE SALE
