Curriculum

As writers we have been continuing to use the story 'Jasper's Beanstalk' to write using amazing sentence starters in our writing. We have been writing our own invented story using all of the skills we have been taught this year to make it more amazing.

As mathematicians we have been learning about division. We have used the technique of sharing to divide numbers into equal groups.

As artists we created clay tiles to commemorate the King's coronation.

As athletes we are learning how to move our bodies safely and balance through our gymnastics unit. We are also learning about races and how to run, throw and jump.

As computing experts we are recapping what we have already learnt on coding and applying this to some trickier programs.

In Science we have been extending our learning about plants by looking at more seeds and planting them to grow our vegetables. We are also thinking about what our plants need next to keep healthy and growing,

In Learning for Life we have been thinking about how to help others feel like they fit into a group.

<u>Phonics</u>

In the week beginning 12th June, Year One children will be taking part in the phonics screening check where they are asked to read 20 real and 20 nonsense words to check their application of phonics. Any practice you can do with the sounds that have been sent home this year would be helpful along with letting them spend time with games on phonicsplay.co.uk focusing on phase 5 revising all sounds.
