Curriculum

As writers we have been writing our own story based on 'Norman the Slug and his Silly Shell'. Our grammar focus for these three weeks are prefixes (un-) and suffixes (-est, -ed, -ing). They have also been using all the tools in our writing suitcase to make their writing as brilliant as it can be.

As mathematicians we have been learning about length and height. This week we have been measuring and comparing items in centimetres (standard units). As well as this we have been learning about capacity and volume.

As artists we have been focusing on sewing. This week we have been using running stitch to create a border and then we have been adding buttons and other embellishments.

As athletes we are learning how to move our bodies safely and balance through our gymnastics unit. We are also learning about races and how to run, throw and jump. We have also been practising for sports day.

As computing experts we have been using Purple Mash to begin building spreadsheets. We have been learning the vocabulary: cells, rows and columns. We have also been using the spreadsheet to calculate simple number sentences.

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In Geography we have been learning about London. We have been exploring the landscape, weather, buildings and transport.

In Learning for Life we have been thinking about how we have changed in our life times.
