

# Worplesdon Primary School – Weekly Update

Dear Parents / Carers,

What a busy week we've had in Year 2! We would like to say a huge well done to Larks class for their fabulous class assembly! We are sure you'll agree that they all did a fantastic job. We also welcomed Year 2 children from Wood Street on Wednesday afternoon. The children all enjoyed a music lesson, speaking to current Year 3 children about what to expect in Year 3 and then watched a violin performance.

In English this week, the children have been tweaking the story 'The Koala Who Could', with a focus on adding imaginative descriptions. Next week, the children will be re-writing a well known story. Some of our children will begin learning about suffixes and will have a go at writing a story based on picture prompts.

In Maths this week, we have been learning about position and direction. Next week, we will be revisiting our learning on time and we will start to introduce telling the time in 5 minute increments.

Our DT topic this half term focuses on food preparation skills. In order to facilitate this, the children will be making fruit kebabs and pitta bread pizzas over the coming weeks. The children will all need permission to take part, as this will involve them eating different foods in class. Please could you email your child's class teacher by Friday 16th June to let us know that you are happy for your child to take part. Fruits we will be providing are: grapes, satsumas, bananas and blueberries. Pizza ingredients we will be providing are: Brown pitta bread, white pitta bread, tomato puree, cheddar cheese, mozzarella, ham, chicken and sweetcorn. We will also provide dairy free cheese. Please also let us know if your child cannot have any of the ingredients listed above.
