### Curriculum

As writers we have been writing our own story based on 'Norman the Slug and his Silly Shell'. Our grammar focus for these three weeks are prefixes (un-) and suffixes (-est, -ed, -ing). They have also been using all the tools in our writing suitcase to make their writing as brilliant as it can be. Next week, we will be writing non-fiction texts about butterflies.

As mathematicians we have been learning about money. This week we have been recognising the value of coins and notes. As well as this we have begun to solve some problems using this knowledge.

As artists we have been finishing off our sewing. This week we have been using running stitch to create a border and then we have been adding buttons and other embellishments.
