Dear Parents / Carers,

What another busy week we've had in Year 2! We would like to say a huge well done to Doves class for their fabulous class assembly! We are sure you'll agree that they all did a fantastic job. In English this week, some of the children have been tweaking the story 'The Weather Monster', whilst some of our children have been learning about suffixes and have had a go at writing a story based on picture prompts. Next week, we will be starting to explore some different styles of poetry.

In Maths this week, we have been revisiting our learning on time and have introduced telling the time in 5 minute increments. We have been very impressed with how well the children have taken to this. Next week, we will be revisiting our learning on 2D and 3D shapes.

New classes and move up day

Next week, the children will be told their classes for Year 3, and parents will be sent home new class lists. This will be on *Tuesday 27th June*. We will spend some time on Tuesday splitting the children into their new classes so they can see who they will be with. They will not see children coming from Wood Street or other schools, but they will be told who is in their class. On *Wednesday 28th June*, it will be move up day. All children will move into their new Year 3 classroom and spend the day with their new Year 3 teacher. Wood Street will also be coming for this day. You will still need to drop your child off, and pick them up at their Year 2 classrooms.

If you would like your child to bring in sun cream to school to reapply throughout the day, that is fine, however we just ask that the children do not share their sun cream with others.
