INFANT FUN SPORTS – REMINDER

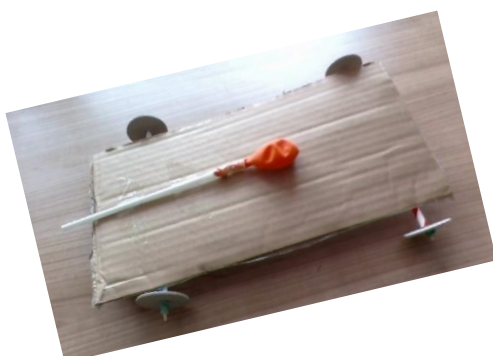

WEEKLY UPDATE FOR EARLY BIRDS AND NIGHT OWLS

At Night Owls this week we have had a DT week where the children have had the chance to make cars, flying objects and boats. The children could make a car from cardboard using straws and bamboo skewers for axles. They then attached wheels, with rubber bands securing them in place. Finally, a straw and balloon could be attached to the top which could be blown up to propel the car across the floor. We had some successes but also some not so successful ones! Boats could be made from either a foil container or a scourer sponge, alongside using cardboard, felt and a lollipop stick for a sail. The children then had great fun testing their boats out in our tuff tray filled with water. They had races, seeing whose could go the furthest and whose stayed afloat or sank! The flying objects were made from paper and straws and worked really well, flying great distances.

Next week we are going to having an art focused week where the children can use a variety of resources to create pictures of their own choice using their imaginations!
