Dear Parents / Carers,

What another busy week we've had in Year 2! The children had such a great day on Wednesday, meeting their new teachers and teaching assistants and spending the day as Year 3's!

In English this week, we have been exploring some different styles of poetry (haikus, tankas and acrostic poems). The children have really enjoyed this and have produced some lovely poetry. Next week, we will be revisiting the story of Augustus and his Smile. The children will have the opportunity to invent their own story based on this story that they already know, and show off all of the writing skills they have learnt in Year 2.

In Maths this week, we have been revisiting our learning on 2D and 3D shapes. The children have been introduced to shape nets and had a go at making 3D shapes from a net. We were so impressed with their resilience and perseverance! Next week, we will be solving problems involving multiplication and division.

SATs Results and Teacher Assessment

Next week, the children will be bringing home their end of year reports (Friday 7th July). These reports will share our final teacher assessment judgements in reading, writing, maths and science. Within the report envelope, you will also find the children's SATs results.

You may find that the SATs result is different to our teacher assessment judgement found on your child's report. This is because we use the SATs papers as one small part of our evidence for assessing the children at the end of Key Stage 1. Teachers have used children's work, observations and other evidence collected in class, alongside the SATs papers to come to a final judgement. As a team, we have moderated together throughout the year, and are confident in our teacher assessment judgements.
