Dear Parents / Carers,

Peter Pan

As you know, our Peter Pan production is next week! Doors will open around 1:15 for the 1:30 performance on Wednesday afternoon and around 5:45 for the 6:00pm performance on Thursday evening. We look forward to seeing you there.

Evening Performances

For our evening performance of Peter Pan on Thursday 6th July, it would be absolutely amazing to have as many of the children back for this performance as possible. If you can get your child back to school, we'd be extremely grateful as each and every child makes up such an important part of the production. The children may arrive back at school for 5:30, using the side gate by the hall. They will need to head up to their classroom where their class teacher will be waiting.

Medication-Residential

If your child has an inhaler, they will be asked to hang on to these so they can use them as required but if they have a spare, please bring that in for us to carry. If for any reason you cannot bring in the medication early, please hand it to their group leader on the morning of the residential.

Reports

Today, you will have received a ParentMail with information regarding end of year reports and SATs results. However, as a reminder, please see the following message below:

As you know, in addition to teacher assessment, children sit SATs (Standard Assessment Tests) in GPS, reading and mathematics. Due to the nature of tests, children's results can differ from the teacher's assessments on their end of year reports. For example, a teacher may assess a child at 'meeting age-related expectations' but the test result states they are 'working towards age-related expectations'.

The children's results will be sent home with their end of year reports however we need to inform you of a change of date regarding receiving these.

As some of you may know, the rest of the school's end of year reports are due to be sent home next Friday 7th July. Unfortunately, the children's SATs results don't arrive till week commencing 10th July, the week of our residential which all Year 6 staff are attending. Therefore, end of year reports and SATs results will be sent home on Tuesday 18th July.
