# Curriculum

As writers we have been writing letters to our new teachers. We have been focusing on showing off all our brilliant learning by using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. They have also been using all the tools in our writing suitcase to make their writing as brilliant as it can be.

As mathematicians we have continued to look at the place-value of each digit in a 2 digit number up to 99. We ordered numbers, and found one more and one less than a given number and compared numbers. We have also been solving problems using these numbers.

As artists we explored the work of Andy Goldsworthy. The children have been creating pieces of art using things that can be found outside.

As athletes we are learning how to move our bodies safely and balance through our gymnastics unit. We are also learning about races and how to run, throw and jump.

As Religious Experts we have been exploring some of the parables that Christians believe Jesus told and thinking about how these teach Christians how to live their lives.



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In Learning for Life we are learning about changes that have happened in our lives and how to cope with them, for example, starting school.

# Safeguarding

As you know, every child's safety is our priority every day. Whilst there are many systems and processes involved in our Safeguarding, one aspect is our fire drill, lockdown drill and whole school evacuation. Throughout the year, we have led successful termly drills for our fire procedure and lockdown procedure. We now need to practise our full evacuation procedure. We hope we would never need to use this however an example would be if there was a gas leak and we needed to evacuate the site, all staff would walk the children down to the FLGCA Community Centre on Fairlands. Once there, we would work with services to evaluate the situation and decide on next steps (e.g. whether sae to return after some time or whether we would need to call parents to collect). On **Monday 17<sup>th</sup> July**, we will be practising this evacuation which will involve all children walking down to the FLGCA Community Centre then back again. Mrs O'Brien has shared this in assembly with the children today and we have attached a social story that has been read to the children in class today and will be re-read on Monday.

We are delighted to inform you that after an overwhelming response from parents to change our P.E. uniform, we will be changing our uniform to:
