Safeguarding-Evacuation

Whilst there are many systems and processes involved in our Safeguarding, one aspect is our fire drill, lockdown drill and whole school evacuation. Throughout the year, we have led successful termly drills for our fire procedure and lockdown procedure. We now need to practise our full evacuation procedure. We hope we would never need to use this however an example would be if there was a gas leak and we needed to evacuate the site, all staff would walk the children down to the FLGCA Community Centre on Fairlands. Once there, we would work with services to evaluate the situation and decide on next steps (e.g. whether sae to return after some time or whether we would need to call parents to collect). On Monday 17th July, we will be practising this evacuation which will involve all children walking down to the FLGCA Community Centre then back again. Mrs O'Brien has shared this in assembly with the children today and we have attached a social story that has been read to the children in class today and will be re-read on Monday.
