Dear Parents / Carers,

What a fab first full week in Year 3! The children have continued to settle well into new classes and routines. They have also been making lots of new friends.

In English this week, we have been exploring the story 'The Day the Crayons Quit' and have been focusing on writing sentences using conjunctions. We have been so impressed with the children's writing! Next week, we will tweak the story by changing the piece of stationary that is complaining. We will continue to focus on conjunctions.

In Maths, we have started looking at the place value of 2 digit numbers, before moving on to look at the place value of 3 digit numbers. We have introduced the children to hundreds, tens and ones using concrete resources and pictorial models. Next week, we will continue our work on place value to 1000.

Thank you to all of the parents who attended our parent information session yesterday. We hope that you found it useful. We will be recording over the presentation and will get it out to parents so that those who could not attend have the same information.

Reading at home

We are really encouraging children to read at home 4 times a week. Teachers/teaching assistants will be checking children's reading diaries on Wednesdays. Children who have recorded 4 reads at home from Wednesday-Wednesday will be entered into a class draw to win a prize. This might be sitting in the teachers chair for a lesson, sitting next to a friend for a lesson, having the teacher glue in their work for the whole day etc. This really motivates the children to read at home. If your child has read a book from home or a book from the library, this can also be recorded in their reading diaries.
