The children have studied a new text in English-Midas and the Golden Wish, and have imitated this story with a focus on sentence structure. They have also used teamwork skills to place key events from the Ancient Greek time period in chronological order. In Science, our topic this half term is Living Things and their Habitats-our first lesson in the sequence focused on Conditions for Life.
