Dear Parents / Carers,

What another fab week in Year 3! The children have now started guided reading in class and have had fun with some painting.

In English this week, we have been continuing to explore the story 'The Day the Crayons Quit' with a focus on writing sentences using conjunctions. We have been so impressed with the children's writing! Next week, the children will invent their own letter based on the letters in 'The Day the Crayons Quit'. They will be writing from the point of view of an angry piece of furniture.

In Maths, we have continued looking at place value. We have now introduced place value counters alongside base 10 (dienes) as concrete resources. The children have been working within 1000 this week. Next week, we will continue our work on place value to 1000, by comparing and ordering numbers.

We will be doing art at various points throughout the year, involving paint, oil pastels etc. As you can appreciate, this can get messy. It would be helpful if all children had an art apron (or an old t-shirt from an adult) that they could put on over their uniform to protect their clothes.
