Worplesdon Primary School – Weekly Update

Dear Parents / Carers,

What a great first half term we have had. Thank you so much for all your help and support so far this year, we really feel like the children have settled into new routines with ease and risen to the challenge of whole class teaching. We started the week with a WOW as the children found a Beanstalk in the corridor with a trail of jellybeans at the bottom. At the top of the beanstalk we found the story 'Jack and the Jelly Bean Stalk' which the children have absolutely loved reading. We have been orally rehearsing the story and creating a bank of wonderful adjectives describing the jelly beans that Jack finds. In science this week the children have been self-selecting materials to build a boat that needs to both float and hold up to 4 marbles. We found that some materials were impermeable but didn't float, some floated but were absorbent so by using multiple materials children we able to create sturdy, durable and impermeable boats.

Next week: Half term woohoo!

After half term we continue our writing on Jack and the Jelly Bean Stalk. In maths we are still building upon addition and subtraction knowledge to 100. Our History topic takes us away from The Great Fire of London and on to The Titanic. We will kick this off with our trip in the second week back to Sea City Museum, this crosses over to our DT lessons looking at levers and axels building up to making our very own Titanic Ship.
