Dear Parents / Carers,

We can't believe we have already reached the first half term of Year 3! The children have settled so well and made some fantastic progress, we can't wait to see what the rest of the year holds. They definitely deserve a break!

In English this week, the children have been inventing their own stories based on Captain Flinn and the Pirate Dinosaurs, using prepositional phrases to express time and place. We have been very impressed with their writing stamina and imagination. After half term, we will be moving on to explore the story 'The Rainbow Fish', with a focus on expanded noun phrases.

In Maths, we have continued looking at addition and subtraction to 1000 with exchanging. As always, the children have had concrete resources to support their learning. After half term, we will begin to introduce the formal written method for addition and subtraction (column method). We will begin with no exchanging, and ensuring the children are confident with the layout of these style of questions.

Art aprons

We will be doing art at various points throughout the year, involving paint, oil pastels etc. As you can appreciate, this can get messy.
