We have introduced column addition and subtraction with no exchanging, and ensuring the children are confident with the layout of these style of questions. Next week, we will be moving on to column addition and subtraction, with exchanging.

Helping at home

Many of you asked us during parent's evening how you can further support your child at home. We subscribe to TimesTable Rockstars, which is a brilliant online resource the children can use to learn their times tables. We will also be sending out a list of Year 3 common exception spelling words. We recommend learning one a week, as the children already have a busy day at school and Atom homework to complete.

We will also be exploring how to resolve conflicts and how this might make us feel.
