

Worplesdon Primary School – Weekly Update

We have had a brilliant week this week, the children have really enjoyed learning and singing all of our songs for our nativity. The children have also started attending some of assemblies and Mrs O'Brien has been really impressed with all of the children during these assemblies.

This week's learning:

In Phonics, the children have learnt; y, z, zz, qu, ch and the harder to read and spell words; she, he. In Literacy, the children have been reading Whoops-A-Daisy Angel (our nativity), retelling the story and drawing and labelling pictures from the story. In Maths, the children have been learning 1 more and 1 less working with numbers 1, 2 and 3. We used rhymes and puppets to help with this. In Expressive Arts and Design, the children have been learning more songs for the Nativity.

Next week's learning:

In Phonics, the children will be learning; sh, th, ng, nk and the harder to read and spell word; push. In Communication and Language, the children will be retelling Whoops-A-Daisy Angel (our nativity), focusing on using their loud and clear voices and knowing their cue to say their lines. In Maths, the children will be focusing on how many different ways they can make 1, 2 and 3. One of the ways we will be doing this is by having three double sided counters and throwing them onto the table, and seeing how many different combinations we can make. In Expressive Arts and Design (EAD), the children will be learning and practising their songs for the nativity, coming up with actions to go with the words.
