We have had a brilliant week this week, the children have really enjoyed singing all of our songs for our nativity.

This week's learning:

In Phonics, the children have learnt; sh, th, ng and nk and the harder to read and spell word; push. In Literacy, the children have been reading Whoops-A-Daisy Angel (our nativity), retelling the story and drawing and labelling pictures from the story. In Maths, the children have been representing numbers 1, 2 and 3. They have been finding different number combinations to make these numbers. They have been explaining their findings in full sentences. In Expressive Arts and Design, the children have been recapping songs for the Nativity.

Next week's learning:

In Phonics, the children will be learning; ai, ee, igh and oa and the harder to read and spell words; was, her. In Literacy, the children will be adding labels to drawings and photos of the Nativity. In Maths, the children will be learning 2D shapes triangle and circle. We will be discussing the features of these shapes and explaining in full sentences. In Expressive Arts and Design (EAD), the children will be practising their songs for the nativity.
