



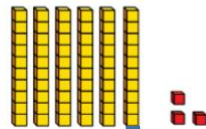

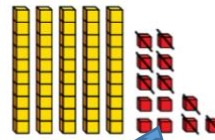
Use base 10 to calculate $63 - 9$
