Dear Parents / Carers,

Welcome back, and happy new year, to you and your children! We hope that you had a restful break. We have been very impressed with how the children have settled back into school. We would also like to say a huge thank you for all of the gifts and cards we received just before the end of term, they were all very much appreciated!

In English this week, the children have been learning about performance poetry and have had a go at writing their own rhyming nonsense poem inspired by the famous poem 'On the Ning, Nang, Nong'. We have been very impressed with their rhyming skills and performances! Next week, we will be moving on to write a non-chronological report all about the character of Toothless from 'How to Train your Dragon'. Our focus will be on paragraphs.

In Maths, we have been doing some work around the three times tables. The children have been counting in 3's, multiplying and dividing by 3 and solving problems around the three times tables. We feel the children have done well with this, and it would be great for them to practise on Times Table Rockstars to ensure they feel confident. Next week, we will be moving on to learn about the 4 times tables. As always, the children have access to concrete resources to help with their understanding.

Swimming UPDATE

As you know, as part of the KS2 National Curriculum, the children are required to have swimming lessons as part of PE. We are now in a position to confirm that swimming lessons will begin on Monday 19th February. In the previous Year 3 update, it stated that there would be 11 swimming sessions. This has now been reduced to 10 (with £8 less to pay), due to an INSET day which was not confirmed at the time of booking.
