Our learning

This week, we have been writing our own autobiographies in English, using dictionaries to improve our spellings and written outcomes. Our Maths has focussed on factor pairs and how to use them to solve multiplication problems.

In **Maths**, we will be completing our step on factor pairs. We will then look at multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100. *What do you notice when multiplying by 10 and 100? How can you use multiplying by 10 to help you multiply by 100?*

In **English**, we will be starting our new unit on Wilma Rudolph, thinking about the use of possessive apostrophes. We will explore her life and write our own biography about her.

In **Foundation** – our History will look at a timeline of the Ancient Egyptians; our RE is looking at the leadership qualities that Jesus has; and in Science, we will be looking at everyday electrical appliances.
