Our learning

Next week, in **Maths**, we will be looking at dividing by 10 and 100. We will spot that it is the same as moving the digits 1 or 2 place value to the right (instead of the left for x10/100). Questions we will ask will include: *What do you notice when dividing by 10/100? Why does this happen? What happens to the digits when you divide by 10/100?*

In **English**, we will continue our unit on famous sports people, thinking about the use of possessive apostrophes. We will explore the life and accomplishments of a chosen athlete and write our own biography about them.

In **Foundation** – our History will look at artefacts and secondary sources to research the Ancient Egyptians; our Computing will involve creating animations; and in Science, we will be looking at building electrical circuits.
