As writers we have been writing a retelling of our new text 'Lost and Found'. We have been focusing on using conjunctions in our writing (and, but, so).

As scientists we have continued to look at different animal groups. This week we focused on reptiles and amphibians and the features of these.

As athletes we are continuing Send and Return and Hit and Catch.

As historians we have been exploring real-life artefacts on our trip to Milestones.

As computing experts we have continued to learn about coding using 2Code to write our own code and extend it to debugging given code.
