## Our learning

Next week, in Maths, we will be continuing to learn some written methods for multiplication, including multiplying a 3-digit number by a 1-digit number.
This week, we have used partitioning, number lines and place value columns to help us. We will be teaching children short multiplication but using place value resources to help them visually see the exchanging. Please see an example of what we will be teaching in the
 image here.

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In English, we will innovate, changing the $3^{\text {rd }}$ paragraph of Tadeo Jones to come up with a different type of treasure saved by Tadeo. We will ask children to design their own challenge faced within the tomb, pyramid or crypt.
