There are 4 equal groups with 2 in each group.

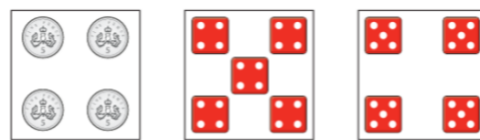


There are 2 equal groups with 4 in each group.
