Participation on the M:Tech course also now includes access to the new 'MyMTech' home platform, where learners can develop their ideas, skills and create music at home.


Happy International Women's Day and Happy Mother's Day/Special Person Day for Sunday. We hope you manage to find a few precious moments to relax and unwind.
