It has been an exciting week, we had a police van visit us on Monday and today we have been excited to wear our pyjamas to school!

This week's learning:

In Phonics, the children continued to review all previously taught sounds and harder to read and spell words, we introduced the new harder to read and spell words: little, one, do. In Maths, we continued to combine two groups to make a certain number. In Literacy, we have been learning about the emergency services. We drew pictures of the emergency services and wrote simple sentences to say how these people help us. In PSED, the children learnt about how to go to sleep and we talked about why it is good for you to sleep. In PE, the children will be focused on movement. They learnt how to hop, step and jump in time with the music and how to play hopscotch. Unfortunately we were unable to be visited by the ambulance this week as they had emergencies to attend to. We did however manage to be visited by the police on Monday!

Next week's learning:

In Phonics, we will continue to review all previously taught sounds and harder to read and spell words. We will introduce new harder to read and spell words; children, love. In Literacy, we will be learning about the people who can help us at Wisley (our school trip on Thursday) we will write a sentence about how they keep us safe. In Maths, we will be comparing length using mathematical vocabulary to describe. In PSED, we will be learning about the importance of washing our hands and keeping healthy. In PD, the children will be playing games to teach them about the space around them, some of the games are 'freeze and fire' and 'tag'. On Friday we are hoping to be visited by the Metropolitan Police, they will be travelling down from London so as always if there is an emergency they may be unable to attend. Please support us with keeping this a surprise to the children.
